




Four proven methods for handling small tumours

1 Mirror blocking

• Snap freeze sample and retain. Use mirror face for diagnosis. If diagnosis is equivocal use frozen sample.

Tumour content assessment on mirror face




3 Core biopsy

- Use biopsy gun on standard sample
- Or open sample first to find best location.



2 Block punches

• Take multiple 2mm punches from a fresh tissue block. Use periphery for tumour content.



Punch samples from selected locations

4 Fine Needle Aspirate

- Flush with phosphate buffered saline.
- Repeat until confident of enough material.
